

- Construction of a new 38,000 square foot office building adjacent to the existing Dickstein Cancer Treatment Center, located on the White Plains Hospital campus, and significant overhaul of the first floor, front lobby and façade of the cancer treatment center itself.
- New six-story building connects three levels to the cancer center and more than doubles the size of the Hospital's cancer facility to 70,000 square feet. Infusion capacity was increased from 18 to 35 stations and the cancer center remained open at all times. Specialized engineering precautions were taken to prevent construction related vibration from impacting the precision based treatments in the lower level radiation oncology.
- Additional work included new examination and treatment rooms, offices, conference rooms, restrooms and amenities spaces. A new pharmacy was constructed in the basement of the new medical office building.
- The project featured a new two-story structural glass vestibule and a suspended porte-cochere, and landscaped areas surrounding the project. An existing four-story brick building was removed from the site at the location of the new structure.
- Construction management services included: budgeting, value engineering, subcontractor bid and award, safety and logistical planning, pre-purchase program, scheduling, phasing and construction.
